The undersigned understands as a participant, he/she has the responsibility to exercise due care for the safety of himself/herself and others.

The parties agree that they will not hold the City of Roanoke, the Harrison Museum of African American Culture, their officers, agents, employees and volunteers harmless from any and all suits, claims or liability of any type, including attorney fees for loss, injury or damage to persons or property resulting from or arising out of undersigned use of or presence on the City or private property during the arts and merchandise sale located at Elmwood Park between the hours of 10:00 am to 11:59 pm Saturday, September 17, 2022. *When submitting Certificate of Insurance to cover the above items, the certificate shall include the City of Roanoke & Harrison Museum of African American Culture as additional insureds.*
